


John Boyle O'Reilly Scholarship NYC Bus Trip on 4/1/2017



The John Boyle O'Reilly Scholarship Committee is chartering a bus to New York City that is set to roll on Saturday, April 1, 2017. Additionally there will be a limited number of premium matinee tickets available to see the play "The Glass Menagerie".

A revival of Tennessee Williams' *The Glass Menagerie* will play the Belasco Theatre, for an exclusive 21 week run with an opening night on March 9, 2017. This classic play will be revived in a production directed by Sam Gold (*Fun Home*), with the role of Amanda Wingfield portrayed by the renowned actress **SALLY FIELD**. Furthermore, the part of Tom Wingfield will be played by Joe Mantello (*The Normal Heart*), the role of the Gentleman Caller Jim O'Connor will be played by Finn Wittrock (*Death of a Salesman*), and the role of Laura Wingfield will be played by Madison Ferris making her Broadway debut. *The Glass Menagerie*, often referred to as a "memory play," was first produced in 1947, and tells the story of a restless young man, his Southern belle mother, and his painfully shy sister who is introduced to a gentleman caller.

The bus will leave from the John Boyle O'Reilly Club at exactly 7:00 am. Instructions for the drop off and pick up destinations will be given the day of the trip. In the past we've had a few drop off points and one pick up point. For those interested in going to the 911 Memorial the bus will drop you off but you will need to find your way back to Times Square where there will be one pick up point determined by the bus driver for our ride home. The exact pick up time, location and bus identification will be provided on the day of the trip. There will be one stop on the way to NYC with NO stops on the way home. The bus is instructed to go directly to the John Boyle O'Reilly Club on the way home.

The price of chartering the bus, including the bus driver's tip, is \$45.00 per person. A small portion of the ticket cost will go towards a scholarship to a deserving student of a club member's parent or grandparent. The price for the play and bus, including all ticket handling fees and bus driver's tip, is \$135.00 per person for Orchestra seats (only 20 seats available). Reservations with payment for the bus and the musical are due by February 9, 2017. Reservations with payment for the bus only are due by March 15, 2017.

Because the seats on the bus and for the play are limited we cannot guarantee your reservation without payment. These reservations are non-refundable since we do not get a refund from the bus company or the theater for any cancellations. In the event you cannot make it, we will try to get somebody to buy your seat and/or play ticket but will not guarantee it.
